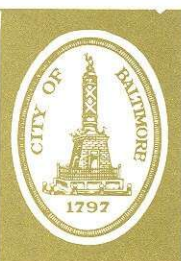

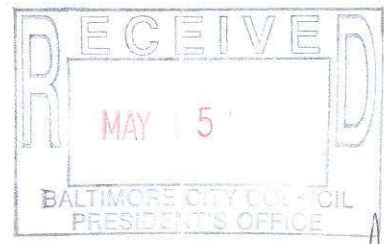

City Council Bill #13-0179 has been introduced for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain parcels of land known as the former beds of certain streets and alleys or portions of them bounded by North Avenue, Warwick Avenue, Baker Street, and the CSX Transportation Inc. Railroad Right-of-way, and are no longer needed for public use.

City Council Bill #13-0179, if approved, will authorize the sale of portions of former right-of-ways of Thomas Avenue, Presbury Street, and Whitmore Avenue to be utilized for parking in conjunction with the construction of a new Science and Technology Center at Coppin State University. This development is a component of the University's Facilities Master Plan.

Based on the above findings, the Department of Finance has no objection to the passage of Council Bill 13-0179.
