## AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

## Charles Village Development District – Amending Ordinance 04-849

- FOR the purpose of amending Ordinance No. 04-849 to modify the infrastructure improvements to be financed in the Charles Village Development District.
  - By repealing and reordaining, with amendments
- 5 Ordinance 04-849 6 Section(s) 1(f)

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7 Recitals

The Tax Increment Financing Act, Article II, Section (62) of the Baltimore City Charter (the "Act") authorizes the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to establish a "development district" (as defined in the Act) and a special, tax increment fund into which the revenues and receipts from the real property taxes representing the levy on the "tax increment" (as defined in the Act) for the development district are deposited, for the purpose of providing funds for the development of the development district.

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 04-849 enacted by the City Council on November 22, 2004, and approved by the Mayor on November 29, 2004, the City has:

- (i) designated the Charles Village Development District (the "Development District");
- 17 (ii) created the Charles Village Development District Tax Increment Fund;
- 18 (iii) provided that until special obligation bonds issued with respect to the Development
  19 District have been fully paid, the property taxes on real property in the Development
  20 District shall be divided as provided in the Tax Increment Act; and
- (iv) made other findings and determinations with respect to the Development District.

9	have the meanings indicated:			
10	(f) "Infrastructure improvements" means the following			
11	public infrastructure improvements constructed in			
12	accordance with all required City approvals:			
13	(1) the design and construction of streetscape			
14	improvements, including installation and/or			
15	modification of curbs, gutters, sidewalks,			
16	lighting, landscaping, street furniture, and			
17	utilities;			
18	(2) the acquisition of [land for public] parking			
19	facilities THAT ARE PUBLICLY OWNED OR			
20	PRIVATELY OWNED BUT SERVE A PUBLIC			
21	PURPOSE, INCLUDING LAND AND OTHER
