**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

**Snow and Ice Removal – Sidewalks**

6 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
7 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

10 **Part VII. International Property Maintenance Code**

11 **§ 7-102. City modifications.**

12 The additions, deletions, amendments, and other modifications adopted by the City are  
13 as follows:

14 **Chapter 3. General Requirements**

15 **Section 305 Exterior Sanitary Maintenance – General**

16 **305.8 SNOW AND ICE ON SIDEWALKS.** AFTER ANY SNOWFALL THAT RESULTS IN AN  
17 ACCUMULATION OF SNOW OR ICE ON THE GROUND, THE SNOW AND ICE MUST BE REMOVED  
18 AND CLEARED AWAY FROM ALL SIDEWALKS THAT ABUT THE PREMISES.

19 **305.8.1 TIME FOR COMPLIANCE.** THE SNOW AND ICE MUST BE REMOVED AND CLEARED  
20 AWAY:

- 21 1. WITHIN 3 HOURS AFTER THE SNOW HAS STOPPED FALLING; OR  
22 2. IF THE SNOW STOPPED FALLING BETWEEN 3 P.M. AND 6 A.M., BEFORE 11 A.M.

23 **305.8.1 MANNER OF COMPLIANCE.** THE SNOW AND ICE MUST BE REMOVED AND  
24 CLEARED AWAY IN A MANNER THAT:

- 25 1. LEAVES A CLEAR PATH THAT IS AT LEAST 2 FEET WIDE; AND  
26 2. DOES NOT OBSTRUCT THE PASSAGE OF WATER IN THE GUTTERS.

1 **[§ 50-46. Cleaning pavements required.**

2 (a) *In general.*

3 After any snowfall that results in an accumulation of snow on the ground:

4 (1) every person using or occupying in any manner, or for any purpose, any house,  
5 store, shop, stable, or tenement of any kind;

6 (2) every person having charge of any church or public building of any kind; and

7 (3) the owner of any unoccupied house or unimproved lot situated on any paved  
8 street, lane, or alley in the City,

9 must remove and clear away the snow or cause it to be removed and cleared away from  
10 the foot pavement fronting the house, store, shop, stable, church, building, or lot.

11 (b) *Time and manner.*

12 (1) The snow must be removed and cleared away:

13 (i) within 3 hours after the snow has stopped falling; or

14 (ii) if the snow stopped falling between 3 p.m. and 6 a.m., before 11 a.m.

15 (2) The snow must be removed and cleared away in such a way as not to obstruct the  
16 passage of water in the gutters.

17 (c) *Penalties.*

18 Any person who violates any provision of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor, and on  
19 conviction, is subject to a fine of not more than \$15 for each offense.]

20 **[§ 50-47. Keeping pavements and gutters clear.**

21 (a) *In general.*

22 Every person described in § 50-46 of this Part must keep the gutters leading to, and the  
23 pavements or sidewalks situated in the front, rear, or sides of the premises, free from ice  
24 and every obstruction of any kind.

25 (b) *Penalties.*

26 Any person who fails to comply with this section within 3 hours after being notified to do  
27 so by any police officer is guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction, is subject to a fine  
28 of not more than \$15 dollars for each offense, plus \$15 for each day the obstruction  
29 continues.]

**[§ 50-48. Removal by City on noncompliance.**

It shall be the duty of the police officers to cause the snow and ice to be removed by those persons employed by the Department of Public Works engaged in snow removal from foot pavements fronting the houses, stores, stables, churches, public buildings, lots, or tenements of such persons as shall neglect or refuse to remove the same, at the expense of the City in the first instance, to be afterwards recovered from the person or persons so neglecting or refusing.]

**[§ 50-49. Enforcement by citation.**

(a) *In general.*

In addition to any other civil or criminal remedy or enforcement procedure, this Part may be enforced by issuance of:

- (i) an environmental citation under City Code Article 1, Subtitle 40 {"Environmental Control Board"}; or
- (ii) a civil citation under City Code Article 1, Subtitle 41 {"Civil Citations"}.

(b) *Method not exclusive.*

The issuance of a citation to enforce this Part does not preclude pursuing any other civil or criminal remedy or enforcement action authorized by law.]
