> City Council Bill 09-0330 {Zoning - Video Lottery Facilities} Re:

Dear Madame President and City Council Members:

The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 09-0330 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill would amend the Baltimore City Zoning Code to define "video lottery facility" and allow a video lottery facility as a permitted use in the B-2 and M-2 zoning districts. While the Zoning Code applies City-wide, video lottery facilities would not be allowed in any location other than the Carroll Camden area due to state law provisions. See Md. Constitution Art. XIX, Section 1(c)(3)(v).

The bill is consistent with State laws on video lottery terminals. See Md. Constitution Art. XIX, Section 1; Chapter 4 of Maryland Chapter Laws of 2007 Special Session (SB 3 of 2007 S1). Therefore, the Law Department approves Council Bill 09-0330 for form and legal sufficiency.
