**OECR POSITION: No Recommendation**

**SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION**

The Office of Equity & Civil Rights (OECR) has reviewed and is herein reporting on City Council Bill 24-0539 – *City Streets - Renaming Cromwell Street to Vision Street*. This is a bill that would rename Cromwell Street, a road that will be central to the Port Covington redevelopment area of the Baltimore peninsula, to Vision Street.

**CONCLUSION**

The Office of Equity & Civil Rights has reviewed City Council Bill 24-0539 and **defers its recommendation** on the legislation to that of the Department of Planning.
