I am herein reporting on City Council Resolution 22-0108R introduced by Council Members Torrence, Ramos, and Bullock.

The purpose of the Resolution is to invite representatives from the Departments of Recreation and Parks and Public Works to provide information on the Druid Lake and Ashburton water tank projects, including a general overview highlighting the importance of the projects; an updated timeline for the completion of the projects; a summary of the environmental implications of the projects and any corrective actions taken on environmental issues reported to the Maryland Department of the Environment; an assessment of the scope of the projects and whether they are on track to stay within the allotted budget; a detailed description of the proposed park amenities and restoration; a discussion of Recreation and Parks' plan to maintain Druid Lake Park during the ongoing construction work; and an assessment of how these projects align with equitable neighborhood development for the surrounding communities.

Representatives of the Department of Public Works will attend the hearing on City Council Resolution 22-0108R and provide information pertaining to the two underground water tank projects, the importance the projects play in the distribution of water to customers, their current status, the restoration of the impacted areas, and the anticipated timeline to complete them.
