Re: City Council Bill 08-0156 City Streets - Closing - Adams Street


The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 08-0156, which was introduced for the purpose of condemning and closing Adams Street, extending from Ponca Street, Easterly 152.2 feet, more or less, to the end thereof, as shown on Plat 114-A-35 in the Office of the Department of Public Works.

The adjacent property owner, G&F Property Investments, LLC, requests the closing of this portion of Adams Street in order to consolidate it within the development site for the construction of a full-service car wash facility. In reality, the construction of the I-895 right-of-way already has rendered this particular section of roadbed as defunct and therefore existing only on plat maps.

The Department of Housing and Community Development has no objection to the adoption of City Council Bill 08-0156.
