I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 13-0182 introduced by Council President Bernard Jack Young at the request of the Department of General Services.

The purpose of this bill is authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain parcels of land known as the former beds of a portion of Fremont Avenue and (2) portions of Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard lying between Fairmount Avenue and Hollins Street, and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

The Baltimore City Parking Authority reviewed the proposed legislation and determined that there would be no negative impact to parking in the area as a result of this legislation.

Based on the above comments, the Baltimore City Parking Authority supports the passage of City Council Bill 13-0182.
