On July 14, 2010 the Board had before it for consideration
the following pending City Council Bills:

✓ 09-0382 - An Ordinance concerning Sale of Property - Portion of
1900 Argonne Drive, Lot 2A, Block 5387 and a Portion
of Lot 2, Block 5387 for the purpose of authorizing
the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at
either public or private sale, all its interest in
certain parcels of land known as a portion of 1900
Argonne Drive, Lot 2A, Block 5387 and a portion of Lot
2, Block 5387 and no longer needed for public use; and
providing for a special effective date.

09-0424 - Sale of Property - Block 530, Lot 43/46 (the Mayfair
Theater Dressing Rooms) for the purpose of authorizing
the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at
either public or private sale, all its interest in
certain property known as Block 530, Lot 43/46 (the
Mayfair Theater Dressing Rooms) and no longer needed
for public use; and providing for a special effective
date.





- 10-0481 - Charter Amendment - Redistricting Plan for the purpose of modifying the time by which the Mayor must submit a redistricting plan to the City Council; clarifying and conforming related language; and submitting this amendment to the qualified voters of the City for adoption or rejection.
- 10-0499 - Charter Amendment - Procurement for the purpose of establishing new procedures for establishing and modifying certain bid threshold amounts, bid and performance requirements, advertising requirements, award criteria, and other matters governing procurement; and submitting this amendment to the qualified voters of the City for adoption or rejection.

After NOTING AND CONCURRING in all favorable reports received, the Board approved the Bills and referred them to the City Council with the recommendation that they be approved and passed by that Honorable Body.

The President ABSTAINED from voting.
