10 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the
11 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

12 **Baltimore City Code**

13 **Article 31. Transit and Traffic**

14 **Subtitle 13. Baltimore City Parking Authority**

15 **§ 13-4. General powers.**

16 (h) *Contracts.*

17 (1) The [authority] AUTHORITY may enter into contracts necessary or convenient to the
18 exercise of its powers.

19 (2) The Authority's contracts are not subject to Article VI, § 11 of the City Charter.

20 (3) However, any contract involving an expenditure of [\$10,000] \$25,000 or more is
21 subject to the approval of the Board of Estimates.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

1 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
