At its regular meeting of June 25, 2009 the Planning Commission considered City Council Bill #09-0334, for the purpose of repealing Ordinance 05-31, approved May 16, 2005, which granted permission to Printers' Square Apartments Limited Partnership, to use and maintain a private enclosed bridge way above and across the Hunter Street right-of-way; and providing for a special effective date.

In its consideration of this Bill, the Planning Commission reviewed the attached agenda, summary and previous staff report which recommends approval of City Council Bill #09-0334 and adopted the following resolution, seven members being present (seven in favor).
