## **Major Issues Discussed**

- 1. Councilmember Middleton opened the meeting, introduced committee members and read the bill into the record.
- 2. Councilmember Cohen commented about the purpose of the bill. He explained that certain community groups support the bill.
- 3. Martin French presented the Planning Commission's report which supports the bill. Planning Department staff recommended disapproval, but based on information gathered at the department's hearing the Planning Commission issued a recommendation of support for the rezoning. Mr. French read the Planning Commission's resolution into the record.
- 4. Liam Davis testified that the Department of Transportation has no objection, but would like to evaluate site plans if a proposed restaurant for the site moves forth.
- 5. Agency representatives provided reports for their respective agencies.
- 6. Ms. Caroline Hecker testified on behalf of the applicant in support of the bill. She provided background information about the property and proposed use. The bill is a companion to Bill 21-0051, which rezones the property.
- 7. The committee opened the hearing for public testimony.
- 8. The committee approved a motion to amend the bill.
- 9. The committee approved a motion to recommend the bill favorably with amendment.
- 10. The hearing was adjourned.
