Re: **City Council Bill 17-0110 – Baltimore City Landmark List: Exteriors – Our Saviour
Lutheran Church**

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 17-0110, for the purpose of designating Our Saviour Lutheran Church, 3301 The Alameda, as an historical landmark: exterior.

The Our Saviour Lutheran Church was constructed in 1929/1930 with the Gothic Revival architectural style. It is located in the Ednor Gardens-Lakeside Neighborhood and Councilwoman Clarke introduced Bill 17-0110 for the designation of the exterior of the Church as an historical landmark.

The Department of Housing and Community Development supports the passage of City Council Bill 17-0110.
