A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation –**  
3 **Department of Public Works – \$952,000**

4 FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation in the  
5 amount of \$952,000 to the Department of Public Works – Program 674 (Surface Water  
6 Management), to provide funding for additional operating expenses; and providing for a  
7 special effective date.

9 Article VI - Board of Estimates

13 **Recitals**

14 The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the Beverage Container  
15 Tax in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy  
16 required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2011.

17 This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of  
18 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated.

19 This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the  
20 Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated or is for a new program that could  
21 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.

22 On June 21, 2010, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City  
23 Council.

24 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That  
25 \$952,000 shall be made available to the Department of Public Works – Program 674 (Surface  
26 Water Management) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year  
27 2011, to provide funding for additional operating expenses. The source of revenue for this  
28 appropriation is from the Beverage Container Tax in excess of the amount from this source that
