10 11 12	ALL CITY PROPERTY SHALL BE INSPECTED AT LEAST ONCE A YEAR TO ASSURE THAT ALL ELECTRICAL WIRING, APPLIANCES, AND EQUIPMENT IN, ON, OR IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT TO THE PROPERTY ARE IN GOOD CONDITION, SAFELY PLACED, AND PROPERLY SECURED.

14	If any safety hazard or potential safety hazard is discovered:
15	(1) THE AREA AFFECTED SHALL IMMEDIATELY BE CLOSED; AND
16	(2) CORRECTIVE ACTION TAKEN TO ELIMINATE THE HAZARD OR POTENTIAL HAZARD.
