At its regular meeting of September 2, 2010, the Planning Commission considered CCB #10-0588, which is for the purpose of approving the issuance by the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners of the Baltimore City Public School System of its revenue bonds, designated "School System Revenue Bonds (Qualified School Construction Bonds)" and "School Revenue Bonds (Refunding Bonds)", subject to certain conditions; requiring certain statements, disclosures and reports; and providing for a special effective date.

In its consideration of this Bill, the Planning Commission reviewed the attached staff report which recommends approval of City Council Bill #10-0588 and adopted the following resolution, nine members being present (nine in favor).

RESOLVED, That the Planning Commission concurs with the recommendation of its departmental staff, and recommends that City Council Bill #10-0588 be passed by the City Council.
