I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 16-0679 Street Encroachment – 201 North Schroeder Street for the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the construction and maintenance of a portion of a building projecting into the public right-of-way on the east side of North Schroeder Street, the north side of Lexington Street, and the west side of North Amity Street of the property known as 201 North Schroeder Street.

If enacted, this bill and companion bill 16-0680 (Street Encroachment – 101 North Schroeder Street) would allow a portion of the Park Square Homes development to encroach on City owned property. Park Square Homes represents the first phase of the 13.8 acre Poppleton Center West development. The first phase of the development is expected to include 262 residential rental housing units and 17,413 square feet of commercial/retail space in two buildings.

DOT supports this bill.
