The purpose of this legislation is to designate the Upton Mansion, 811 W. Lanvale Street, as a historical landmark...

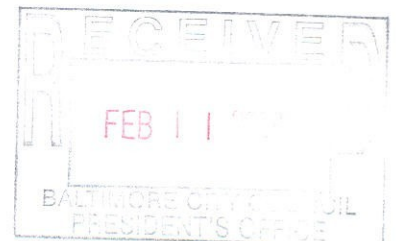
