AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

Annual Property Tax – Fiscal Year 2023

1
2 FOR the purpose of providing a tax for the use of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for
3 the period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023; and setting the semiannual payment service
4 charge for that period.

5 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That for
6 the period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023, a tax is levied and imposed for the use of the
7 Mayor and City Council of Baltimore on all property in the City of Baltimore (except property
8 exempt by law), as follows:

9 (a) except as otherwise specified in item (b) of this section, a tax of \$2.248 is levied and
10 imposed on every \$100 of assessed or assessable value of real property; and

11 (b) a tax of \$5.62 is levied and imposed on every \$100 of assessed or assessable value of:

12 (1) personal property; and

13 (2) operating real property described in State Tax-Property Article § 8-109(c).

14 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this tax shall be paid and collected in the
15 manner prescribed by law including the provisions of Section 10-210 of the Tax-Property Article
16 of the Annotated Code of the Public General Laws of Maryland.

17 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That for the period July 1, 2022, through
18 June 30, 2023, the semiannual payment service charge to be imposed under State Tax-Property
19 Article § 10-204.3 is 0.20%.

20 **SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is
21 enacted.
