16	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents money from the Maryland
17	Department of Aging State fund in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in
18	determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2025.
19	That funding could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the Ordinance of
20	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2025 was formulated.
21	On October 2, 2024, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
22	Council.
