Re: **City Council Bill 16-0744 - City Streets – Opening –  
A Portion of South Eden Street and a Portion of Aliceanna Street**

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 16-0744, for the purpose of condemning and opening a portion of South Eden Street, extending from Lancaster Street northerly 308 feet, more or less, to Aliceanna Street, and a portion of Aliceanna Street, extending from South Central Avenue easterly 170 feet, more or less, to South Eden Street, as shown on Plat 235-A-42 in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

If enacted, this bill, a companion bill to City Council Bill 16-0745, would allow portion of streets to be closed to support the development of a new 22 story mix used building for commercial and residential use in the Inner Harbor neighborhood.

The Department of Housing and Community Development supports the passage of City Council Bill 16-0744.
