North Holliday Street, as a historical landmark: public interior.

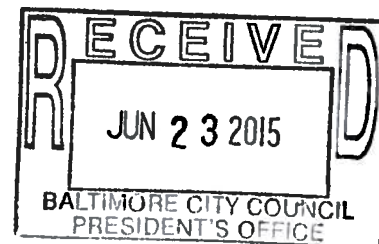
The BMZA has reviewed the legislation and supports the passage of Bill Number 14-
