The Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) is reporting on City Council Bill No. 23-0375 introduced by Councilmember Ramos on May 1, 2023.

### **PURPOSE**

This Bill would change the name of the REACH! Partnership School Field, located at 2555 Harford Road Baltimore, MD 21218, to Senator Robert L. Dalton Stadium.

Senator Robert L. Dalton was born on March 10, 1927 in Leaksville, NC, where he attended public schools. A graduate of Winston Salem Teachers College and NC A&T College, Dalton served as a member of the Maryland State General Assembly from 1971-1974.
