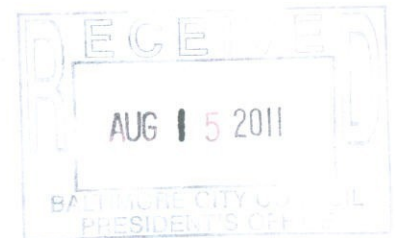
RE: Bill No. 11-0731 Baltimore City Landmark List: Franklin-Delphey Hotel
