**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

1                                    **Baltimore City Landmark List – Olmsted Parkways**

2    FOR the purpose of designating the Olmsted Parkways, which consist of the ~~public right-of-way~~  
3    medians and sidewalks of the 2600-3200 blocks of the Alameda, the ~~public right-of-way~~  
4    medians and sidewalks of the 0000-1800 blocks of 33<sup>rd</sup> Street, and the ~~public right-of-way~~  
5    medians and sidewalks of the 1600-3900 blocks of the Gwynns Falls Parkway, as a ~~historical~~  
6    ~~landmark~~ historical landmarks; clarifying that a building permit is not needed for necessary  
7    repair or maintenance of or to these medians and sidewalks; and specifying the scope of  
8    CHAP’s review of all proposed changes in these medians and sidewalks.

14        **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the

19    **§ 13-35. OLMSTED PARKWAYS.**

20        (A) DESIGNATION.

1           (1) ~~(A) THE THE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY MEDIANS AND SIDEWALKS~~ OF THE 2600-3200  
2           BLOCKS OF THE ALAMEDA;

3           (2) ~~(B) THE THE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY MEDIANS AND SIDEWALKS~~ OF THE 0000-1800  
4           BLOCKS OF 33<sup>RD</sup> STREET; AND

5           (3) ~~(C) THE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY MEDIANS AND SIDEWALKS~~ OF THE 1600-3900  
6           BLOCKS OF THE GWYNNNS FALLS PARKWAY.

7           (B) PROCEDURES.

8           (1) IN ACCORDANCE WITH CITY CODE ARTICLE 6, §§ 4-9 AND 4-11, A BUILDING  
9           PERMIT IS NOT REQUIRED FOR ANY NECESSARY REPAIR OR MAINTENANCE OF OR TO  
10           THESE MEDIANS AND SIDEWALKS.

11           (2) THE COMMISSION FOR HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL PRESERVATION WILL:

12                   (1) REVIEW ALL PROPOSED CHANGES TO THESE MEDIANS AND SIDEWALKS,  
13                   EXCEPT THOSE FOR NECESSARY REPAIR OR MAINTENANCE; AND

14                   (II) CONSIDER TRAFFIC, SAFETY, AND ENGINEERING IMPLICATIONS WHEN  
15                   REVIEWING THESE PROPOSED CHANGES.

16           **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance  
17           are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior  
18           Ordinance.

19           **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
20           after the date it is enacted.
