12	(a) Affixing to new buildings.
13 14 15 16	The owner of any new house or other building shall affix or place on the premises, in the manner prescribed in this subtitle, the correct number of [said] THAT house or other building, as determined and fixed by the Department of Public Works [when the said house or other building has been substantially completed].
17	(b) Maintaining on all.
18 19 20	The owner or occupant of any house or other building shall affix and shall at all times [keep affixed] MAINTAIN on the premises the correct number of [said] THAT house or [any] other building, as determined and fixed by the Department of Public Works.
21	§ 6-7. [Arabic numerals; visibility] REQUIRED DISPLAY.
22	The correct number of every house or other building:
23	(1) shall be displayed in Arabic numerals;

4	(A) IN GENERAL.
5	In addition to any other civil or criminal remedy or enforcement procedure,
6	THIS SUBTITLE MAY BE ENFORCED BY ISSUANCE OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL CITATION AS
7	AUTHORIZED BY CITY CODE ARTICLE 1, SUBTITLE 40 {"ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL
8	Board"}.
9	(B) Process not exclusive.
10	The issuance of an environmental citation to enforce this subtitle does not
11	PRECLUDE PURSUING ANY OTHER CIVIL OR CRIMINAL REMEDY OR ENFORCEMENT ACTION

14	(A) IN GENERAL.
15	Any [owner or occupant failing to comply with or violating] PERSON WHO VIOLATES any

17	AND, ON CONVICTION, subject to a fine of not more than [\$10] \$500 for each offense [and
18	to an additional fine of \$10 for every day that such noncompliance or violation shall
