City Council Bill #10-0621 has been introduced for the purpose of modifying the parking limitations within the Morgan Residential Parking Area (Area 2); and generally relating to the Residential Permit Parking Program.

This Bill, if passed, would change residential parking in Area 2 (Morgan) for all non-permit holders from a 2 hour limitation to a 1 hour limitation anywhere within the residential parking area.

This incremental adjustment is expected to have a small impact on revenue. Initial parking citations may increase. However, behavior is expected to change shortly thereafter, mitigating the initial spike in the issuance of tickets. Therefore, the Department of Finance has no objection to the passage of Council Bill #10-0621.
