14	§ 13-4. Exceptions.	
15	(a) Discharges not into sanitary facilities.	
16	Whenever any property upon which the charge imposed hereunder uses water from the	
17	City's water supply system or any other source or sources [for an industrial or	
18	commercial purpose] in such a manner that the water so used is not discharged into the	
19	sanitary facilities of the City, the quantity of water so used and not discharged into the	
20	City's sanitary facilities shall be excluded in determining the charge imposed hereunder	
21	as to said property if the quantity of water so used and not discharged into the City's	
22	sanitary facilities is measured by a device or devices approved by the Director of Public	
23	Works and installed without cost to the City.
