BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a parking, open-off street area on the property known as 5809-5817 Park Heights Avenue, as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 4-904(1) and 14-102, subject to the condition that the following conditions:
 - 1. The Site Plan for this open off-street parking lot, entitled "Jewish Community Center Off Site Parking Lots" and dated "January 17, 2006", is made a part of this Ordinance. No change may be made to the Site Plan without the prior approval of the Planning Department.
 - <u>2. The parking, open off-street area complies must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements.</u>
 - **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat;
