Development Plan of the Port Covington Planned Unit Development.

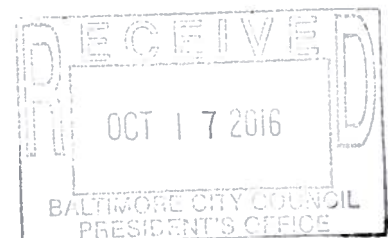
The BMZA has reviewed the legislation and concurs with the Planning Commission's
