AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

**Zoning – Conditional Use Parking, Open Off-Street Area –
1621, 1623, 1625, 1627, 1629, and 1631 Gough Street**

FOR the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a parking, open off-street area on the properties known as 1621, 1623, 1625, 1627, 1629, and 1631 Gough Street, as outlined in red on the accompanying plat.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a parking, open off-street area on the properties known as 1621, 1623, 1625, 1627, 1629, and 1631 Gough Street, as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 4-1104 and 14-102, subject to the ~~condition that the~~ following conditions:

1. Should this lot be sold to another entity and become separated from the church, the new owner will be required to provide the required 1 handicapped space within the parking, open off-street area with the appropriate striped zone.
2. The parking, open off-street area ~~complies~~ must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat;
