I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 09 - 0411 introduced by Council President Stephanie Rawlings-Blake at the request of The Comptroller (Department of Real Estate).

The purpose of this bill is authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain property known as 4900 Boston Street (Block 6820, Lot 055), and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

The Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. reviewed the proposed legislation and determined there would be no operational or fiscal impact to any administered parking programs for on-street parking activity and/or City owned off-street parking facilities resulting from this Bill's passage.

Based on the above comments, the Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. supports the passage of City Council Bill 09 - 0411.
