3 FOR the purpose of designating The Mount, 3706 Nortonia Road, as a historical landmark.

9 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
10 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

13 **Subtitle 12. Landmark List - 2000s**

14 **§ 12-17. THE MOUNT.**

15 THE MOUNT, 3706 NORTONIA ROAD.

16 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
17 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
18 Ordinance.

19 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
20 after the date it is enacted.
