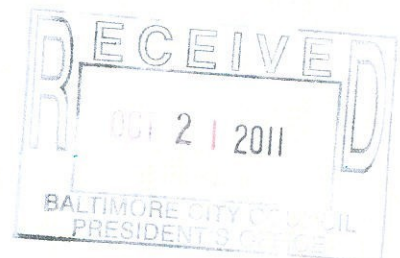
RE: Bill No. 11-0774 Baltimore City Landmark List: "St. Peter the Apostle Church Complex"
