The Environmental Control Board (ECB) has placed this bill on the agenda for the Board meeting on May 25, 2011. It is understood that this legislation to modify the requirements for development projects which overlap to mitigate their impact on City traffic patterns will require that violations from the specification set down by the various city agencies may result in an environmental citation. This would add to the numbers that are currently heard before the ECB administrative hearings.

The process will definitely impact this agency operationally and a study has to be done to see how many are anticipated per year to clearly determine how it will impact this agency. At this point ECB defers to the core agencies that have had an opportunity to evaluate the details of the proposed bill.
