Ladies and Gentlemen:

City Council Bill No. 21-0085 has been referred by your Honorable Body to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals for study and report.

Pursuant to Article 32, Section 5-507(b) the BMZA shall provide reports on legislation submitted to the City Council Section per Section 5-501(2) which includes the following: (i) a variance; (ii) a conditional use; (iii) a map amendment; (iv) an educational campus master plan; (v) a hospital general development plan; (vi) an area of special sign control; and (vii) a planned unit development. As this Bill seeks to amend the Building Code, the BMZA, as a quasi-judicial agency, will not be providing a report or comment.
