City Council Bill 14-0464 seeks to prevent human trafficking in Baltimore City hotels. The bill would require all City hotels to register with the City, prohibit hotels from renting out rooms for less than a half day period, require all hotel employees to receive training on human trafficking identification, define terms pertaining to human trafficking, and provide for penalties connected to human trafficking in City hotels.

The Finance Department has reviewed this bill and does not anticipate any impact on City revenue.
