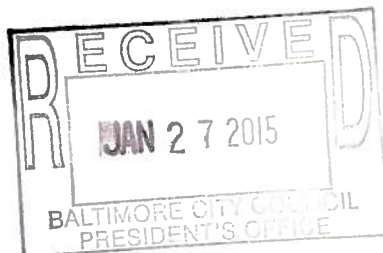
**Re: City Council Bill No. 14-0397
