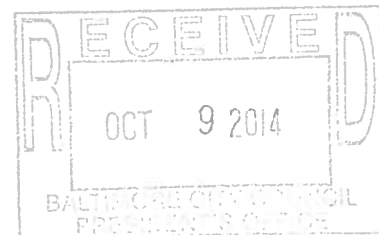
Dear President and City Council Members:

The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 14-0422 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill would allow the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development to sell 5000 Gwynn Oak Avenue. The bill also provides for an immediate effective date.

Article II, Section 15(c) of the City Charter grants the City the power to sell property for development or redevelopment. The powers granted under this section have been vested, as allowed by subsection (g), in the Department of Housing and Community Development, pursuant to Section 2-7 of Article 13 of the City Code. The Law Department approves this bill for form and legal sufficiency.
