A COUNCIL RESOLUTION CONCERNING

1 Recognizing February as Career and Technical Education Month

2 FOR the purpose of recognizing February as Career and Technical Education Month.

3 Recitals

4 **WHEREAS**, February is Career and Technical Education Month;

5 **WHEREAS**, Career and technical education is education that directly prepares high school
6 students for successful careers;

7 **WHEREAS**, Career and technical education covers many different fields, such as health care,
8 information technology, advanced manufacturing, hospitality, the arts, and business; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Many Baltimore City Public Schools offer career and technical education,
10 allowing students to access state-of-the-art labs, use professional equipment, learn from industry
11 professionals, and experience internships in their chosen field.

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the City
13 Council recognizes February as Career and Technical Education Month.

14 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, That a copy of this Resolution be sent to the Mayor, the
15 CEO of the Baltimore City Public School System, and the Mayor's Legislative Liaison to the
16 City Council.
