Pronouns

- "BPD members shall use names, pronouns and titles of respect as requested, expressed, or clarified by the person with whom they are interacting"
- Officers will never require "proof" of someone's Gender Identity
- In no circumstances shall BPD members refer to a person as any other pronouns besides how the person requests to be addressed



POLICY 720

Search

- Honor the person's preference about the gender of the member conducting the search
- If no preference is given by the person being searched, then the gender identity of the member conducting the pat down will be consistent with the individual's gender identity
- Gender-affirming items such as binders, wigs, or other cosmetic items shall not be removed unless required to perform a law enforcement action
 - If a gender-affirming item must be removed, the search will be conducted in private.

POLICY 720

Transport

- Transgender/ Intersex people will be transported with other arrestees of the same Gender Identity
 - If a safety concern is raised, the individual will be transported alone
- Nonbinary or Gender Fluid arrestees will be consulted about their preference



POLICY 720

Housing

- While in custody, a transgender person will be consulted on where they would feel safest concerning housing placement if said placement is single sex.
 - Safety placement shall be documented on the member's BWC.
- "Transgender, Intersex, and Gender Non-Conforming individuals shall not be arbitrarily placed in segregated cells solely because of their status or for their protection, unless they have expressly requested to be placed alone."
- While in custody, individuals shall be allowed to use the bathroom that confers with their gender identity.

Safe Place Initiative

- **Collaboration with local businesses**
- Approximately 100 businesses partnered with BPD to date
- Businesses pledge to provide safe harbor and assistance to victims

LGBTQIA+ Liaison is notified when a hate crime is reported



This location is a SAFE PLACE for victims of Anti-LGBTQ crimes and harassment to call 911 and wait for police to arrive.





- Community Partnership Unit Special Liaisons

- LGBTQIA+ Policy and Advisory Board

- Pride At BPD
