This legislation will designate the American Brewery, located at 1701 N. Gay Street, as a Baltimore City Landmark. The Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation approves this legislation and requests that the designation process be completed as soon as possible.

The American Brewery is currently being renovated. The American Brewery is significant for its architectural design [Standard #4] featuring distinguishing Victorian architectural characteristics. The Brewery is also significant for its role in Baltimore's brewing history and its association with prominent Baltimoreans. It served as a brewery from the 1870s to the early 1970s.
