17	described as follows:

19	of Concord Street, 50 feet wide, and the north side of Pratt Street, varying in
20	width, and running thence binding on the north side of said Pratt Street, Westerly
21	50.2 feet, more or less, to intersect the west side of said Concord Street; thence
22	binding on the west side of said Concord Street, Northerly 309.0 feet, more or
23	less, to intersect the south side of Lombard Street, varying in width; thence
