**INTRODUCTION** – Rezoning - 3925 Gough Street

**PURPOSE/PLANS** – For the purpose of changing the zoning for the property known as 3925 Gough Street (Block 6311, Lot 031), as outlined in blue on the accompanying plat, from the I-1 Zoning District to the IMU-2 Zoning District.

**COMMENTS** – Council Bill 19-0474 looks to rezone 3925 Gough Street from the I-1 Zoning District to the IMU-2 Zoning District. The bill’s statement of intent indicates that the property owner intends to redevelop the property for the purposes of allowing for a mixture of commercial and industrial purposes.
