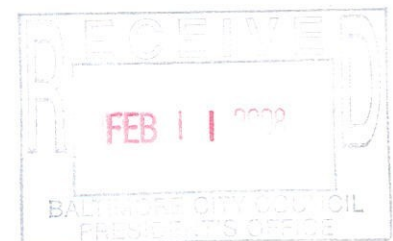
Bolton Park is a modern town house community made up of 35 attached single family units. The complex was built in 1968.
