FOR the purpose of replacing representatives from the Better Greenmount Alliance on the Charles Village Community Benefits District Board of Directors with representatives from the Waverly Merchants Association; and generally relating to the Board of Directors for the Charles Village Community Benefits District.

BY repealing and reordaining, with amendments

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Baltimore City Code

Article 14. Special Benefits Districts

Subtitle 6. Charles Village Community Benefits District

§ 6-6. Board of Directors.

(e) *Minimum representation.*

The following minimum representation shall be present on the full Board, except during periods of temporary vacancies:

(4) At least 6 voting Board members shall be from the following constituent organizations within the District:
