INTRODUCTION – City Streets - Closing - Etting Street and four 10 Foot Alleys bounded by Druid Hill Avenue, Gold Street, Division Street and Baker Street

PURPOSE/PLANS – For the purpose of condemning and closing of Etting Street and four ten-foot alleys bounded by Druid Hill Avenue, Gold Street, Division Street and Baker Street as shown on a plat numbered 337-A-28A and filed in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

COMMENTS – Council Bill 21-0090 looks formally condemn and close a portion of Etting Street, as well as four adjacent ten-foot alleys.
