A RESOLUTION ENTITLED

1 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND City COUNCIL concerning

2 **The Comprehensive Water and Wastewater Plan**  
3 **for Baltimore City**

4 FOR the purpose of adopting a Comprehensive Water and Wastewater Plan for Baltimore City;  
5 and providing for a special effective date.

6 **Recitals**

7 **WHEREAS**, The State of Maryland requires certain counties and the City of Baltimore to  
8 review once every 3 years a comprehensive water and wastewater plan and to adopt amendments  
9 or revisions thereof if such revisions or amendments are deemed necessary by the governing  
10 body of the county or the Maryland Department of the Environment; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Acting on behalf of the City of Baltimore, the Department of Public Works has  
12 prepared a plan as aforementioned; and

13 **WHEREAS**, The City's Capital Improvement Program shall automatically become part of the  
14 Comprehensive Water and Wastewater Plan upon approval of the annual Ordinance of  
15 Estimates; and

16 **WHEREAS**, As minor technical information is received that revises, but does not materially  
17 alter the Comprehensive Water and Wastewater Plan after it has been adopted, it may be added  
18 to the plan as appropriate replacement pages; and

19 **WHEREAS**, The Public Hearing as required by the State has been held.

20 **SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the  
21 Comprehensive Water and Wastewater Plan for Baltimore City, dated 2006, is adopted.

22 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, That in the event it is judicially determined  
23 that any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or part in or of this plan, or the  
24 application thereof to any person or circumstance, is invalid, the remaining revisions and the  
25 application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.
