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**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

**Charles Village Community Benefits Districts Management Authority –  
Council Representatives on Authority Board – Election Approval Process**

FOR the purpose of clarifying that the Councilmembers appointed to the Board of Directors of the Charles Village Community Benefits District Management Authority are voting members of the Board; providing that all members of the Baltimore City Council are eligible to vote in the election approval process; and providing for a special effective date.

BY repealing and reordaining, with amendments

**SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

**Baltimore City Code**

**Article 14. Special Benefits Districts**

**Subtitle 6. Charles Village Community Benefits District**

**§ 6-6. Board of Directors.**

(e) *Minimum representation.*

The following minimum representation shall be present on the full Board, except during periods of temporary vacancies:

5 (b) Eligibility criteria.

6 The following persons are eligible to vote subject to the limitations that no person may  
7 have more than 1 vote:

8 (1) owners of property within the District which is subject to tax under § 6-8; and

9 (2) voters registered to vote within the District; AND

10 (3) ANY CURRENT MEMBER OF THE BALTIMORE CITY COUNCIL.

11 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance  
12 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior  
13 Ordinance.

14 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> 90<sup>th</sup>  
15 day after the date it is enacted.
