3 FOR the purpose of designating Hansa Haus, 11 South Charles Street, as a historical landmark.

5 Article 6 - Historical and Architectural Preservation

6 Section(s) 13-1, to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 13. Landmark List - 2010s”

9 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
10 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

13 **SUBTITLE 13. LANDMARK LIST - 2010s**

14 **§ 13-1. HANSA HAUS.**

15 HANSA HAUS, 11 SOUTH CHARLES STREET.

16 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
17 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
18 Ordinance.

19 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
20 after the date it is enacted.
